## MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF ELECTIONS IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK HELD ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 3, 2023 AT 1:30 P.M. 42 BROADWAY, 6<sup>th</sup> FLOOR, COMMISSIONERS' HEARING ROOM NEW YORK, NY 10004

Mr. Ryan opened the meeting with item #1 of the meeting agenda, the Election of Board Officers for the Year 2023, pursuant to New York State Election Law, Section 3-212(1).
